Daniel 6:18-23

Leader: ¹⁸ Then the king went to his palace, and passed the night fasting; neither were instruments of musick brought before him: and his sleep went from him.

Congregation: ¹⁹ Then the king arose very early in the morning, and went in haste unto the den of lions.

Leader: ²⁰ And when he came to the den, he cried with a lamentable voice unto Daniel: and the king spake and said to Daniel, O Daniel, servant of the living God, is thy God, whom thou servest continually, able to deliver thee from the lions?

Congregation: ²¹ Then said Daniel unto the king, O king, live for ever.

Leader: ²² My God hath sent his angel, and hath shut the lions' mouths, that they have not hurt me: forasmuch as before him innocence was found in me; and also before thee, O king, have I done no hurt.

All Together: ²³ Then was the king exceedingly glad for him, and commanded that they should take Daniel up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no manner of hurt was found upon him, because he believed in his God.
